SUNY Adirondack has a Director of Health and Wellness who coordinates student health and wellness services.

SUNY Adirondack has a partnership with Hudson Headwaters to help students obtain better access to healthcare services. This includes a mobile health unit that is on our campus twice per month to provide walk-up and appointment-based preventative care. Hudson Headwaters works with the college to educate the school's students and staff about the health network's services, specialities and its urgent care and primary care locations. Hudson Headwaters also provides periodic on-site seminars for current and prospective students and members of SUNY Adirondack's faculty and staff.

Hudson Headwaters is a not-for-profit corporation and a federally qualified health center, offering primary care health services in the northeastern region of Upstate New York, including Glens Falls and Queensbury.
