The SUNY Adirondack residence hall is a 48, 000 square foot, 400 bed facility located on the Queensbury Campus. The Residence hall is owned by the ADIRONDACK HOUSING ASSOCIATION, LLC (AHA), a not-for-profit corporation affiliated with the Faculty Student Association (FSA). Opened in the fall of 2013, this state of the art facility provides fully-furnished suite style accommodations with four (4) or five (5) students per suite and also features such amenities as high speed wireless internet, cable TV, an exercise facility, classroom space, a multipurpose meeting space and on-site laundry.
