Business Central

Business Central is the College's hub for services and programming to develop and promote businesses of all sizes, as well as the place to connect community members with SUNY Adirondack faculty and students in pursuit of an entrepreneurial mindset. Business Central coordinates all activities related to the College's work in support of business development and growth, coordinated through the following initiatives:

Career Readiness:

Business Central connects students with regional opportunities and provides career readiness resources. Students can access an online career management tool called College Central Network (CCN) www.sunyadk.com/college_central [1]. Students activate their account in CCN to seek employment, internship and volunteer opportunities as well as access sources and information about career-related campus events. In addition, Business Central offers individual appointments for students to assist in preparing for workforce readiness, including resume and cover letter writing, interviewing skills, thank you letters, and application assistance. Businesses and Entrepreneurs:

Business Central has established partnerships with the area's business development resources to provide business assistance on campus, including Small Business Development Center, U.S. Small Business Administration, SCORE, Center for Economic Growth, Innovate 518, and Accelerate 518. Through its economic development partnerships, Business Central provides current and future entrepreneurs with the resources, workshops and events to turn their business ideas from concepts to reality.
