*PSY 101 and PSY 175 must both be taken during the first fall semester for a CRSA student to progress through prescribed course of study as outlined in the course catalog.

** A minimum of a 3.0 GPA will be necessary to enroll in the Practicum (PSY 280A and PSY 280B) which is required for degree completion. PSY 280B or PSY 281B must be taken during the Spring semester directly following the successful completion of PSY 280A or PSY 281A. PSY 280A and PSY 280B must be taken sequentially or PSY 281A and PSY 281B must be taken sequentially. Students in a particular sequence must stay within that given sequence. This is a fall/spring sequence.
